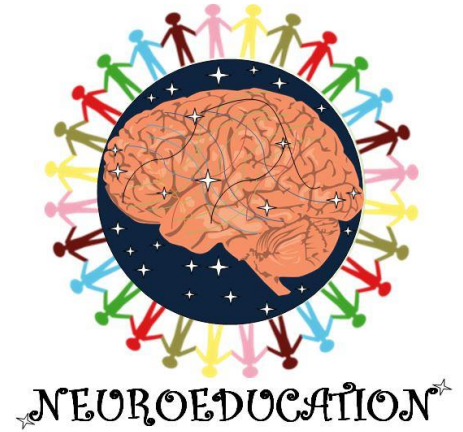


# What influences YOUR learning? How does your brain actually change?
